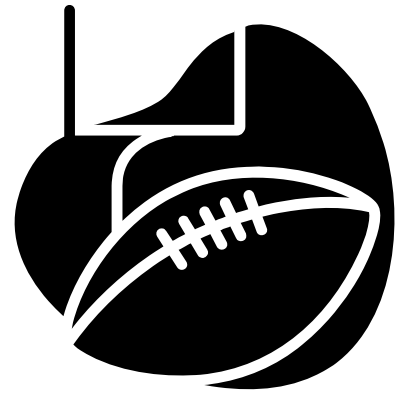

The 2010 Football Season is about to Begin!

Football Players

The Pewaukee Junior Pirate youth football program begins its 15th season in a about a month. We begin this season with the **equipment handout** on **Monday, August 9th** at Pewaukee High School, in the upstairs balcony of the gym. Football equipment will be sized and fitted from 7:00-8:30pm. **8th** grade players will be fitted from 7:00 to 7:20, **7th** grade players from 7:20 to 7:40, **6th** grade players from 7:40 to 8:00 and **5th** grade players from 8:00 to 8:30. Please try to attend at your scheduled time, but come when you can if you have a schedule conflict. Please call your Head Coach if you cannot attend on this date. KM Sports will be on-site that night with a variety of football shoes and accessories for purchase.

The first day of football practice begins on **Tuesday, August 10th** at the PHS athletic fields, 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. Players need only their helmets, football shoes, shorts, mouth guards and tee shirt for the first week. The first 10 hours of our training camp is free from contact and is used for conditioning and player evaluation. Beginning on **Monday, August 16th**, all pads and full practice uniform will be required. Any equipment adjustments can be made before practice begins. From the desks of the Co-Presidents (Pete Bacon and Karl Fritchen)

Thank you for being part of our football family. The high school and youth programs are one. Our philosophy remains the same. Our program will provide our players the fundamentals and skills that they need to learn to be able to compete at the high school level. Although we love to win, player development is placed above winning. We expect our players to attend practice, practice hard, and demonstrate a winning attitude. All players represent our program both on and off of the field.

Players will be divided into platoons and will get a chance to play on offense and defense. Everyone matures at a different pace and we need kids at the varsity level with multiple skill sets. Our program is measured by the type of kids we graduate. We had a wonderful 2009 season and the momentum of our program continues to grow. We enjoyed a second consecutive Woodland Conference Championship and third in the last five years. The number of participants in our youth program continues to increase. We expect about 150 players and another 60 cheerleaders. The growth in our program has provided the high school coaching staff with the resources to begin to platoon at the varsity level so that means more kids will get the opportunity to play at the varsity level. The high school staff continues to hold coaching clinics for our youth coaches to educate them on the proper drills and fundamentals that will prepare them for their high school seasons.

The Pewaukee Youth Football Association is entering its 15th year. At next year's golf outing, scheduled for June 5th, 2011, we will be recognizing the people that started this program. There were a number of people that donated their time, money, and sweat to get this program underway and we are enjoying the fruits of their labor. We are looking to continue to grow our golf outing and we are going to ask each class to provide a representative for our golf planning committee. Our most recent golf outing had over 100 golfers and approximately 140 attendees for dinner. We continue to raise money and invest in our program and great things are on the horizon. Due to an additional donation, we were able to award six \$500 college scholarships. Other investments last season included another video camera, computer, locker room renovation, TV's, and football software.

During our second annual Varsity/Junior Pirate cookout scheduled for August 13th, we will be holding our parent meeting in the home football stands. We ask each family to send one parent to the meeting. Coach Iverson and the Board Co-Presidents will discuss the program philosophy. Each team will break off to hear from their individual team head coach. The parent meeting will last about one hour and will begin promptly at 7PM.

Two important dates this year. Our uniform handout/picture night is scheduled for August 26th. Youth night will be held on Friday, September 3rd. Our Jr. Pirates will form a tunnel for the high school players to run through before the game against Greendale. We had the pleasure of watching our sons be a part of this tunnel and then to eventually run through as a player. Enjoy this time of your life, it will go by quickly!
